
Dear Friends:

Thank you very much for your recent gift of [REDACTED], check number 1012, dated 12/24/2010, to Wayside Christian Mission. Now that cold weather has arrived, we are focusing most of our resources on providing safe, warm accommodations for our homeless families, men, and women. The Good Samaritan Patrol operates daily, combing the streets and camps where people try to survive outdoors, often unaware of the danger of subfreezing temperatures. Mentally ill and intoxicated people sometimes make poor decisions, such as refusing shelter and enduring the cold. Since 1988, Wayside has ministered to these folks by giving them hot coffee, sandwiches, blankets, warm clothing, and, for those who are willing, a ride to the Mission.

As the shelter fills, we transfer as many families and women as possible to the new hotel, freeing up needed space in our Jefferson Street facility. Often, when I leave the shelter in the evening, the beds are filled, and floor space is used to provide a temporary bed during the cold weather. All of our normal services are running overtime. Staff and volunteers struggle to serve the overflow crowd each evening while preparing the shelter for the holiday season.

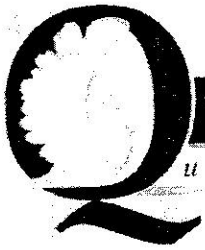
